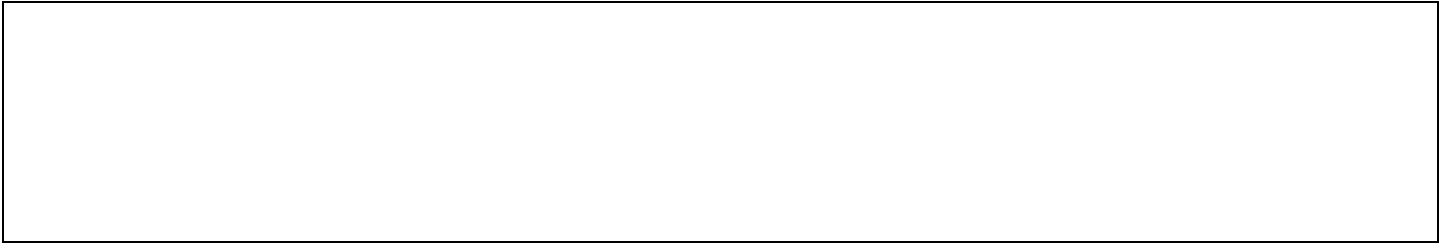

Scott's; The Big Dawg (TAC-10)

Located on the northeast corner of Main and Columbia, this Italianate style building was built between 1876 and the 1900s. Its cast iron details on the front façade accent the common bond brick walls. Segmental arched windows pierce the walls on the second floor. Dentil work is found under the metal cornice. The building was occupied by the Taylor County Enquirer in 1900, Coca-Cola Bottling in the 1920s, Louie the Greek Bar in the 1920s, Scott's, Cato Teen Clothing, and Rusty Tungate's Grill. It is now occupied by a radio station WVLC also known as The Big Dawg.
