Bank of Campbellsville (TAC-13)

Begun in 1887 as Campbellsville's first bank, the Bank of Campbellsville served the community from here until its collapse in 1939. Its officers were members of the Turner family, and it was often referred to as the Turner Bank. The building was then sold to the Taylor County Federal Savings & Loan Association who used it until 1965. A clothing store and Margaret Ann's Gifts and Flowers have since occupied the building. In 1901 a cigar factory operated on the second floor. By 1915, the Telephone Exchange was there. Currently the first floor is occupied by Bryan Bennett's Law Office and the second floor is an apartment.

This three-bay, two-story brick structure is constructed of common bond brick. The stone front on the first floor is pierced by the main arched windows that are accented with keystone. The second floor windows have stone sills and are highlighted with segmental brick arches. A tin cornice is accented with brackets that are decorated with acanthus leaves. The words "BANK OF CAMPBELLSVILLE" appear in its façade.
