

Bass & Bryant Drug Store; Tucker Diamonds & Gold (TAC-17)

One of the oldest buildings in downtown Campbellsville, this two-story building was constructed in 1885 by Samuel R. Bass. As a reminder of his accomplishment, Bass painted his name and the date "1907" on the second floor that remains visible today.

This building is a classic example of the Victorian Italianate style with tall, narrow windows with decorative window hood molds and frieze. Several businesses have occupied both buildings over the years. In 121, the Bass & Bryant Drug Store and Hubbard's Grocery occupied the buildings at the turn-of-the century, followed by Pierce Grocery in 1923, Squire's Grocery and a the Campbellsville Barber Shop in 1947, Gorin Singer Sewing in 1976 and Tucker Diamonds and Gold from 1948 to present.
