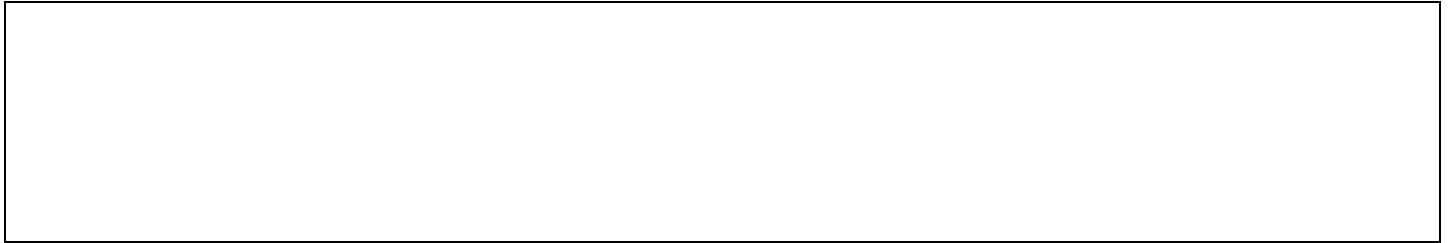

Miss Mary Green Johnson's Millinery (TAC-18)

One of the oldest buildings in downtown Campbellsville, this two-story building was constructed in 1885 by Samuel R. Bass. As a reminder of his accomplishment, Bass painted his name and the date "1907" on the second floor that remains visible today.

Originally Miss Mary Green Johnson's millinery shop was at 123 East Main Street in 1895 followed by the Farmer's Deposit Bank in 1902. The historic pressed tin ceiling remains intact. This bank eventually merged with People's Bank in 1924 and became The Farmer's and People's Bank. The building was also occupied by Wilkerson's Restaurant, then O.B. Finn who sold cold drinks, medicines, perfumes, tobacco, silverware, and books. Young's Jewelry from 1948-1980, later Tucker's began business here, then moved to 121 in 1980. Maxine's Discount Shoes occupied the building until 2011. Currently, Candy Bouquet occupies on this site.
