Taylor County Bank (TAC-22)

This was originally the site of the home of Dr. Sam Chandler. Built between 1896 and 1908, the present two-story sandstone building with marble base had a diagonal corner entry in 1908 and housed the Hord and Hall Hardware Store with a tin shop in the rear. The Telephone Exchange occupied the second floor.

Taylor County Bank opened on this site in 1937 and remained here until its move to the corner of Broadway and Lebanon Avenue. Wise and Lee followed; then Wise, Lee and Buckner; then Wise Buckner Sprowles presently.
