Chandler's Novelties (TAC-36)

Chandler's Novelties, located at 210 East Main Street, was built in 1892. This two-story common bond brick building is three bays wide and has flat arches over the second floor windows with stone sills. Chandler's Novelties is Main Street's oldest continuous business. William A. Chandler began first with a general store and a lunch counter. Joseph William "Chip" Chandler succeeded William. At present, Bill, Chip's son, and his wife Jill own the business. The building was added on to in 1910 by W.C. Jones, contractor.

In 1954, the interior was completely remodeled and a new stockroom built in the rear. In recent years the store has expanded to the adjacent building on the west. Dr. Milton Elliott followed by Dr. Don Bernard occupied office space upstairs.
