Sanders Hardware Store (TAC-37)

In 1894, Charles A. Bridges Sr., building contractor, built this two-story common bond brick building located at 208 East Main Street. It has hood molds over the second floor windows and a decorative tin parapet wall with a cast iron front façade. Brick corbelling creates a decorative pattern that stretches across the front façade. The transom lights are covered with signage.

According to 1908 Fire Insurance Sanborn maps, the building housed a hardware store, probably Sam Sanders Hardware. Subsequent to Sam Sanders' Hardware, Charles Sanders and Tom Disney ran a hardware store. In later years, Oliver Crouch had a poolroom and George and Mildred Willson ran a dress shop, Willson's Blue Bunny, here. Sensations followed. Today Chandler's Office Supply occupies the building.
