U.S. Post Office (TAC-48)

Originally, this was the site of the Borders Home, then a Doctor's Office Building in which Dr. J.L. Atkinson, Dr. W.B. Atkinson, Dr. Frank Buckner, and Dr. Lee Gowdy practiced, and the J.R. McRoberts Home. In 1936, the site was occupied by the former U.S. Post Office. The old post office contained two murals by artist Bert Mullins: one depicting Zachary Taylor in the Seminole War and one with an agricultural theme. Today, the old post office building is occupied by Bertram, Cox and Miller Law offices.
